ORDER

AND NOW, this 10th day of September, 2025, upon consideration of the parties' Proposed Case Management Order filed August 25, 2025, the Court ORDERS that the order filed June 9, 2025, is revised as follows:

- 1. All fact discovery must be completed no later than February 20, 2026.
- 2. Plaintiff shall submit expert reports, if any, in support of his claims no later than March 6, 2026, and shall provide dates for expert depositions within 30 days thereafter.
- 3. Defendants shall submit any responsive expert reports no later than April 3, 2026, and shall provide dates for expert depositions within 30 days thereafter.

- 4. Rebuttal expert reports, if any, shall be submitted no later than April 24, 2026. Each rebuttal expert report shall not exceed 15 pages, excluding exhibits.
- 5. Summary judgment motions and supporting briefs shall be filed no later than May 15, 2026.
- 6. Responses to summary judgment motions and opposition briefs, if any, shall be filed no later than June 15, 2026.
 - 7. Reply briefs, if any, shall be filed no later than July 2, 2026.
- 8. Motions *in limine* and proposed jury instructions shall be filed no later than August 14, 2026.
- 9. Responses to motions *in limine*, if any, shall be filed no later than August 21, 2026.
- 10. The Court will conduct a final pre-trial conference on August 31, 2026.
- 11. Trial in this matter will commence on September 21, 2026, and continue for one to two weeks.
- 12. The parties shall file joint status reports on the progress of discovery every 90 days, with the first report due 90 days after entry of this Order. This first report after entry of this Order is in lieu of the thirteenth joint status report due on or before November 24, 2025.
