

1. All fact discovery must be completed no later than February 20, 2026.
2. Plaintiff shall admit any affirmative expert reports(s) in support of their claims no later than March 6, 2026, and shall provide dates for the expert(s) depositions within the following 30 days.
3. Defendants shall submit any responsive expert report(s) not later than April 3, 2026, and shall provide dates for the expert(s) depositions within the following 30 days.

4. Rebuttal expert reports, if any, shall be submitted not later than April 24, 2026. Each rebuttal expert report shall not exceed 15 pages, excluding exhibits.

5. Summary judgment motions and supporting briefs shall be filed not later than May 15, 2026.

6. Responses to summary judgment motions and opposition briefs, if any, shall be filed not later than June 15, 2026.

7. Reply briefs, if any, shall be filed not later than July 2, 2026.

8. The Parties expect they will request hearing on any Summary Judgment motions.

9. All motions *in limine* and proposed jury instructions shall be filed on _____ [not later than 30 days before trial].

10. Responses to motions *in limine*, if any, shall be filed on _____ [not later than 14 days after submission of the motion or 5 days prior to the pretrial conference (whichever is sooner)].

11. The Court shall conduct a final pre-trial conference on _____ [approximately 2 weeks prior to trial].

12. Trial in this matter will commence on September 21, 2026 [or later at the Court's discretion]. The parties anticipate trial of 1-2 weeks.

13. The Parties shall file joint status reports on the progress of discovery every 90 days.
